SUNBRELLA CONTRACT FABRIC WITH DEFIANCE®



UPHOLSTERY CARE, CLEANING, AND MAINTENANCE

One of the best ways to keep Sunbrella® Contract fabrics looking good is to brush off debris before it becomes embedded in the fabrics and wipe up spills or clean soon after a spill occurs. The quicker you clean spills, the easier they can be to remove.

QUICK TIP — For a new spill or mess on your Sunbrella Contract fabric:

- Blot (don't rub) liquid spills with a clean, dry cloth. For oil-based spills, apply an absorbent such as corn starch, then remove with a straight edge.
- Spray on a mild cleaning solution of soap (such as Dawn or Woolite) and water.
- Rinse the fabric thoroughly to remove all soap residue.
- Air drv.

QUICK TIP — for tougher spills, stains and messes on your Sunbrella Contract fabric:

Though Sunbrella Contract fabrics can be used both indoors and out, your cleaning methods should differ slightly indoors and out because of the fabrication and manufacturing of the furniture. We recommend using the appropriate cleaning instructions for your application.

INDOOR UPHOLSTERY

- Apply a light mist of mild soap and water using a spray bottle.
- Work the solution into the spill by lightly agitating the entire surface area of the fabric, moving from seam to seam, with a sponge or very soft bristle brush.
- Avoid scrubbing, and do not use a hard bristled brush or anything that will abrade the fabric.
- Rinse the entire fabric thoroughly to remove all soap residue.
- Blot excess moisture with a clean, soft towel or sponge.
- Blot or wet-vacuum excess water from the entire surface area of the fabric, moving from seam to seam.
- Air dry. Repeat rinsing and blotting until all soap residue is removed.

Professional Cleaners

Machine Washing

Some removable casings can be washed in the washing machine, however consult the furniture manufacturer before removing the casing as cushion construction may vary. To wash, first close all zippers. Machine wash in cold water on the delicate cycle with normal amounts of mild laundry detergent. Allow fabric to air dry.

Seam-To-Seam Cleaning

When cleaning upholstered pieces, clean the entire surface area of the fabric, from seam to seam, instead of rubbing the fabric in a circular motion on the spill. This method, along with an extractor, may be required in order to avoid water rings and residue.

Oil-Based Spills

Immediately apply an absorbent such as corn starch directly on the oil-based spill. Let sit for 10 minutes and remove the excess using a straight edge or ruler. This helps remove the spill and prevents it from being pressed into the fabric. Then proceed with the cleaning process.

For other spills, products such as Dawn, Resolve® or 303® Multi-Surface Cleaner are applicable. Specific information on spill cleaning is available at commercial.sunbrella.com/stain-chart.

OUTDOOR UPHOLSTERY

Cleaning Removable Fabric

Hand Washing

Soak fabric in a solution of 1/4 cup mild soap per gallon of lukewarm water. Use a sponge or very soft bristle brush to lightly agitate the spill. Then rinse thoroughly to remove all soap residue, and allow fabric to air dry.

Machine washing

Some removable casings can be washed in the washing machine, however consult the furniture manufacturer before removing the casing as cushion construction may vary. To wash, first close all zippers. Machine wash in cold water on the delicate cycle with normal amounts of mild laundry detergent. For severe mold or mildew, add 1 cup of bleach. Allow fabric to air dry.

Cleaning Non-Removable Fabric

Prepare a solution of 1/4 cup mild soap per gallon of lukewarm water. Use a soft bristle brush to clean, allowing the cleaning solution to soak into the fabric. Rinse thoroughly to remove all soap residue and allow fabric to air dry.

Mold and Mildew

Sunbrella Contract fabrics do not promote mildew growth, however, mildew may grow on debris and other foreign substances if not removed from the fabric. To remove mold or mildew:

- Prepare a solution of 1 cup of bleach and 1/4 cup mild soap per gallon of water.
- Spray on entire area and allow to soak into the fabric for 15 minutes.
- Clean entire surface area with a sponge, clean towel or very soft bristle brush.
- Rinse thoroughly to remove all soap residue.
- Air dry.

For severe mold/mildew growth, bleach quantities may be increased.

It is best to clean the entire surface area of the fabric to avoid water rings and residue.



Retreating Sunbrella Contract Fabrics

Sunbrella Contract fabrics are treated with a proprietary water and stain repellent finish that is designed to last for several years, but may require replenishing after a thorough cleaning. Glen Raven® recommends 303® Fabric GuardTM, available in the United States, and Tex'Aktiv, available internationally.

Applying a retreatment:

- Clean Sunbrella Contract fabric, using one of the cleaning methods.
- Allow Sunbrella Contract to completely air dry.
- Apply retreatment in a well-ventilated area following instructions on the container.

For other spills, products such as Dawn, Resolve® or 303® Multi-Surface Cleaner are applicable. Specific information on spill cleaning is available at commercial.sunbrella.com/stain-chart.

Sunbrella Contract with Assure and Defiance Finishes

Follow the normal cleaning instructions for Sunbrella Contract fabric when cleaning the fabric with Assure or the Defiance finishes. Alcohol Isopropyl-based, Hydrogen Peroxide-based, Quat-based, Quaternary Ammonium-based, Sodium Hypochlorite-base, and bleach-based cleaners and disinfectants are safe for the Assure and Defiance finishes.

Disinfectants and cleaners with a PH level of 12 and over should not be used on products with the Defiance finish.

Helpful Hints

Avoid scrubbing, hard bristle brushes or any other abrasive cleaning method.

Sunbrella Contract should only be allowed to air dry.

Protect the area around your Sunbrella Contract fabric when using bleach or other chemical solvents that may discolor non-Sunbrella Contract fabrics. Always rinse Sunbrella Contract thoroughly.

Bleach can have harmful effects on the natural environment around you. Please follow all safety and environmental precautions according to the bleach label.

If fabric has some wrinkling, use an iron on the synthetic setting. As iron temperatures may vary, first test a small inconspicuous area before ironing the entire piece.

DO NOT use a steamer or an iron set to the steam setting.

UPHOLSTERY SPILL AND SPOT CLEANING

GENERAL CLEANING TIPS

- Cleaning is easier and more effective the sooner it is performed.
- Lift liquid spills with a clean, dry cloth.
- Blot, or roll the cloth. Rubbing can force the spill into the fabric.
- Begin with mild cleaning solutions such as soap and water. Use progressively stronger solutions if necessary.
- Bleach and solvents will not damage the fabric but may not be necessary to clean spills.
- Important note: It is not recommended to use phenolic-based cleaners on Sunbrella Contract textiles.
- Avoid scrubbing, hard bristle brushes and anything that will abrade the fabric.
- Thorough rinsing to remove cleaning agent residue is important.
- Avoid excess heat or steam. The fabric will air dry quickly.

FOR LIGHT SPILLS/MESSES

- Remove dried or excess spill by lightly brushing, scraping, or vacuuming, taking care not to abrade or damage the fabric.
- Lift as much liquid spill as possible with a dry, clean cloth, using a blotting or rolling motion to avoid pressing the liquid into the fabric.
- Saturate the spill and surrounding area of the fabric with water and cleaner.
- Use a sponge, clean towel, or soft bristle brush to loosen the spill being careful not to abrade the fabric.
- 5. Rinse thoroughly to remove all cleaning agent residue.
- Wet Vacuum Extraction moving from seam to seam or blot excess water with a clean towel.
- 7. Let the fabric air dry.
- Repeat until the spill is completely removed, or proceed to Stubborn Spills below.

FOR STUBBORN SPILLS/MESSES

- 1. Add 1 cup of bleach and 1/4 cup of soap to 1 gallon of warm water.
- 2. Saturate the affected area using the cleaning solution.
- 3. Use a sponge, clean towel, or soft bristle brush to loosen the spill.
- 4. Rinse thoroughly to remove all cleaning agent residue.
- Wet Vacuum Extraction moving from seam to seam or blot excess water with a clean towel.
- 6. Let the fabric air dry.

Body Fluids

The cleaning procedures on this page can remove blood and other body fluids. Always follow appropriate biohazard safety protocol during the cleaning process.

Sunbrella Contract with Assure and Defiance Finishes

Follow the normal cleaning instructions for Sunbrella Contract fabric when cleaning the fabric with Assure or the Defiance finishes. Alcohol Isopropyl-based, Hydrogen Peroxide-based, Quat-based, Quaternary Ammonium-based, Sodium Hypochlorite-base, and bleach-based cleaners disinfectants are safe for the Assure and Defiance finishes.

Disinfectants and cleaners with a PH level of 12 and over should not be used on products with the Defiance finish.

Specific Spills

Consult the Sunbrella Contract Fabric Cleaning Chart for suggested cleaning agents for specific spills. Always rinse thoroughly to remove the cleaning agent once the spill is removed.

Deep Cleaning

Deep cleaning for large areas or set spills is best accomplished through upholstery wet extraction seam to seam note, being careful to avoid the excess heat of steam cleaning. Consult a professional cleaning service if this expertise is not available.



OUTDOOR UPHOLSTERY

Cleaning Removable Fabric

Hand Washing

Soak fabric in a solution of 1/4 cup mild soap per gallon of lukewarm water. Use a sponge or very soft bristle brush to lightly agitate the spill. Then rinse thoroughly to remove all soap residue, and allow fabric to air dry.

Machine washing

- Reducing Our Carbon Footprint

In 2017, Glen Raven installed a 1-megawatt solar array at the plant in Anderson, South Carolina, capable of offsetting enough annual waste to equal the planting of 2,500 tree seedlings a year, and of harnessing enough energy to power 105 typical homes. A 500-kilowatt solar array at the plant in Norlina, North Carolina allows for energy collection from every direction and produces enough electricity to power 47 typical homes.
