It allows manufacturers of ecologically sound products to demonstrate market leadership in the growing movement toward product transparency and health in the built environment and provides them an expanded point of entry into the world's most groundbreaking sustainable building projects.

It is managed and issued by the International Living Future Institute, an independent organization committed to spreading more environmentally sustainable design choices in the construction sector. It is a voluntary tool that demonstrates the manufacturer's commitment to increasingly responsible construction practices

Declare complies with the requirements specified by the LEED v4 and v4.1 regulations in the "Building Product Disclosure and Optimization" section, particularly concerning the "Material Ingredient Reporting" credit. This credit rewards products that declare and disclose their chemical composition using recognized methodologies, including Declare. All elements that make up the product must be declared, at least up to 1000 ppm (0.1%)
